ABOUT THIS DIRECTORY

The National Mental Health Commission under the Ministry of Health and Wellness is charged with acting as advisor, facilitator, enabler and supporter of the national approach to the mental health reform programme. In fulfilling this mission, public awareness of options for accessing mental health and social services was identified as a key element that required improvement. The Mental Health Directory was developed to close this gap.

The directory and database contain a list of mental health services offered in Barbados including:

- 1. Public providers
- 2. Private providers (psychologists, psychiatrists, occupational therapists) registered with the Paramedical Council as of 2023).
- 3. Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) and Faith-Based Organizations.
- 4. Mental Health Support Services for Students
- 5. Hotlines
- 6. Mental Health Advocacy and Educational Groups

This document is intended to be a living document to reflect any changes in services. 





GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Occupational Therapist

An occupational therapist is a healthcare provider who helps individuals improve their ability to perform daily tasks. They assist in identifying goals and overcoming physical, mental, and social challenges. Occupational therapists support people with mental health conditions in learning new ways of participating in work, school, and leisure activities by regaining or acquiring new skills, and adapting their environment *(or their response to it)* in ways that facilitate easier participation in various activities.

Psychiatrist

A medical doctor who diagnoses and treats mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders. Psychiatrists can order a full range of medical laboratory and psychological tests to assist in diagnosis formulation along with the client interview. This allows them to design a treatment plan tailored to the client which may or may not include the use of medication depending on the need.

Psychologist

A person who specializes in the study of mind and behavior or in the treatment of mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders. They may offer treatment for individuals, couples, families or groups. There are 3 different types of psychologists registered by the Paramedical Professions Council in Barbados: clinical; counseling; educational.

Clinical Psychologist

A psychologist trained in the assessment, diagnosis, formulation, and psychological treatment of mental health, behavioural, and emotional disorders across the lifespan.

They apply theory to clinical practice to understand, prevent, and relieve psychological problems or disorders of varying severity whether mild to severe, chronic, or complex.

Counselling Psychologist

A psychologist who uses culturally-informed and culturally-sensitive practices to help people improve well-being, prevent and alleviate distress and maladjustment, resolve crises, and increase ability to function. Focus is more on therapy versus testing and diagnosis. Typical clients served are those with mental health challenges not severe mental illness.

Educational Psychologist

A psychologist who assesses difficulties children may be having with their learning and provides advice and training on how to help children improve their ability to learn more effectively. This may include working with individuals with specific learning challenges such as attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) or dyslexia.

Psychiatrist vs Psychologist

Similar to psychiatrists, clinical psychologists can diagnose mental disorders. They can also treat some mental disorders with psychotherapy. They can perform a range of psychological tests to assist in diagnosis that psychiatrists are not trained to perform such as intellectual and personality assessments. However, they cannot prescribe medication like psychiatrists since they are not medical doctors. Psychiatrists and psychologists therefore often work as members of a complimentary team.
