Requirements and Guidelines for the Submission of Applications for Provisional Registration with the Barbados Medical Council

- All copies must be certified or notarized with the stamp of the Justice of the Peace or the seal of the Notary Public affixed.
- All submitted documents which are in any language other than English must be accompanied by a certified or notarized English translation.
- All documents must be legible. Illegible documents will be discarded rendering the application incomplete.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION

1. Fully completed application form with a recent color passport size photograph
2. Original document confirming success in final M.B.B.S or M.D. examinations from accredited medical school, or notarised copy of Medical Qualification Document
3. Documentation showing that the applicant is considered for internship programme in Barbados
4. Original valid police (clearance) certificate of character:
 - Made no earlier (older) than six months prior to application
 - Must be issued from the jurisdiction in which the applicant lives and/or works
5. Names, postal address, email address and telephone number of referees should be listed
6. Detailed curriculum vitae (including full biographical data and medical education)
7. Proof of proficiency in the English Language where English is not the first language [The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or equivalent]

8. A form of photo identification - relevant page in passport with identifying information, or National Identification Card if applicant is a citizen of Barbados
9. Such other documents and information as the Council considers necessary in determining the application.
